What we've been working on in the room...

Writing

- We are beginning our writing like a scientist unit.
- The will learn to record, to questions, to hypothesize, and to observe and teach others.
- Students will be encouraged to follow the scientific process of making a hypothesis, conducting experiments, recording observations through writing and sketches, collecting data, and drawing conclusions
- They will write a second grade version of a lab report.

Literacy

- The students are using text features to locate information in non-non-fiction texts.
- We are on unit 9 for spelling this week. Our pattern is vowel teams. (ee and ea)

Math

- They will be learning how to compare numbers using what they know about place value
- The will be using what they know about place value to skip counting starting at any number.

Social Studies

 Students will be looking at various sources such as artifacts to see what information they provide about the past.
