### What we've been working on in the room...

#### Writing

- We are continuing our writing like a scientist unit.
- They will practice how to record, to questions, to hypothesize, and to observe and teach others.
- Students will be encouraged to follow the scientific process of making a hypothesis, conducting experiments, recording observations through writing and sketches, collecting data, and drawing conclusions.
- They will write a second grade version of a lab report.

#### Literacy

- The students will be identifying the main purpose of a text, including what the author wants to answer, explain or describe.
- We are on unit 10 for spelling this week.

#### Math

- We will be learning the different strategies on how to add two digit numbers. Some strategies are proof drawings, expanded method, number lines and hundreds chart. These different strategies will help build their number sense and mental math.

#### Social Studies

- Students will be learning about timelines and creating their own.

#### Science

- Students will learn about the relationship between sound and vibrating objects.
