What we've been working on in the room...

Writing

- We are beginning our writing like a scientist unit.
- They will learn to record, to question, to hypothesize, and to observe and teach others.
- Students will be encouraged to follow the scientific process of making a hypothesis, conducting experiments, recording observations through writing and sketches, collecting data, and drawing conclusions.
- They will write a second grade version of a lab report.

Literacy

- The students are continuing to practice how to use the images in informational text to add meaning to what they are reading.
- We are on unit 8 for spelling this week.

Math

- Students are learning how to represent numbers in multiple ways.
 - Expanded form, word name, standard form and place value blocks
- They are using the 100's board to find patterns they notice in numbers. For example, when a number increased by ten only the tens place changes.
- They will be learning how to compare numbers using what they know about place value
- They will be skip counting starting at any number.

Social Studies

- Students will be looking at various sources such as artifacts to see what information they provide about the past.

Science

- Students will learn about the relationship between sound and vibrating objects.
- They will learn how an eardrum works
- They will learn about pitch and volume
