What we've been working on in the room...

Writing

- Students will be completing our poetry unit this week
- Students have learned how to write the following various poems and will be publishing their poetry café books!

Literacy

- We are continuing to focus on fictional texts as we take a closer look at the main character as we identify various character traits the character exhibits
- We are beginning to make deeper connections to characters as we relate to characters and how they respond to events and challenges

Math

- Recognize and draw shapes having specified attributes, such as a given number of angles or a given number of equal faces.
- Identifying attributes of triangles, quadrilaterals, pentagons, hexagons, and cubes
- Defining parallel lines and parallelograms
- Describing properties of quadrilaterals, parallelograms, rectangles, and squares.
- Categorizing quadrilaterals, and showing their relationships among quadrilaterals.
- Use geoboards to create pentagons, hexagons, quadrilaterals, triangles, etc.

Social Studies

- We are beginning our economics unit and understanding the difference between goods and services
- Students will learn how to identify people who provides goods and services to the community

Science

- We have been looking at what important things we need to know in order to forecast weather
- Students have been assigned groups and responsibilities in recording data for their designated weather tools
