# What we've been working on in the room...

### <u>Writing</u>

- Students will begin working on our poetry unit this week
- Students will learn how to write the following poems:
  - Acrostic
  - Rhythm and Rhyme
  - Alliteration
  - Repetition
  - Onomatopoeia
  - Haiku
  - Shape Poem

#### <u>Literacy</u>

- We have been working on fictional texts as we take a closer look at the main character as we identify various character traits the character exhibits
- Identifying the different character traits and providing examples to support/ prove our thinking
- Understanding how the main character responds to challenges they face in the story

#### <u>Math</u>

- We have worked on adding and subtracting 2-digit numbers when solving word problems involving dollar bills, quarters, dimes, nickels, and pennies, using \$ and ¢ symbols appropriately. Example: If you have 2 dimes and 3 pennies, how many cents do you have?
- Explain why addition and subtraction strategies work, using place value and the properties of operations in relation to money
- Composing and decomposing different combinations of coins to show the exact same value

## Social Studies

- We are beginning our economics unit and understanding the difference between goods and services
- Students will learn how to identify people who provides goods and services to the community

## <u>Science</u>

- We will be working on our weather unit this quarter
- Students will learn how to collect and record weather leading up to a culminating project which they will present to a 5<sup>th</sup> grade class
