We will continue to explore the properties of vibrations and sound as they investigate how objects of different lengths produce different sounds

What we've been working on in the room...

Writing

- We are continuing to work on writing like a scientist by creating a hypothesis, conducting experiments, recording observations, and drawing conclusions.
- Students are learning about the process of writing "lab reports" so that others can perform the same tasks that they essentially have completed themselves.

Literacy

- During our literacy block, we are still continuing to practice the importance of locating text features and their purpose
- We have been understanding the author's purpose using P.I.E. (Persuade, Inform, Entertain)
- We also are continuing to practice how to determine the author's purpose when reading both informational and nonfiction texts.

Math

- We been learning how to add 2-digit numbers with the following strategies: Place value drawings, Number line, Expanded form, and All totals method
- These various strategies will help students see the value of the digits and therefore the process has more meaning, rather than the standard algorithm.
- Also, we have been working on problem solving with using addition of 2-digit numbers within word problems.

Social Studies

- Understanding the important roles people play in history
- Understanding the impact that historical figures continue to contribute to our society

Science

- Students will understand how sound is created through vibrations
- Students will make kazoos and explore how the sounds are made
